Chief Complaint

Simon Murphy is a 52 year old male. The "Chest Pain" screening questionnaire was administered. The following are his responses.

History of Present Illness

#1. "Chest Pain"

Timing

He reported: Chest pain comes and goes.

He denied: Chest pain occurring more and more often.

Severity

He reported: Chest pain mild aching.

He denied: Chest pain sharp and getting worse.

Quality

He reported: Squeezing heavy chest pressure.

Location

He reported: Chest pain moves to arm and spread to the left arm or shoulder.

Context

He reported: Chest pain associated with other symptoms.

He denied: Chest pain caused by walking up steps or hills. Chest pain, pressure, or discomfort with activity.

Modifying Factors

He reported: Chest pain relieved by rest.

He denied: Chest pain worse when swallowing. Chest pain made worse by moving arms, reaching, or twisting body. Chest pain made worse by taking a deep breath.

Associated Signs and Symptoms

He reported: Chest pain sometimes accompanied by sweating.

He denied: Chest pain causes hands, feet, and lips feel numb and caused loss of consciousness. Shortness of breath with chest pain. Nauseated along with the chest pain.
